



## N-SCALE REPORT by Don Bonk

The 6<sup>th</sup> Ohio N-Scale Weekend (May 16 -18) was a successful event with 7 major module layouts from Ohio and 3 others; from Illinois, New Jersey and West Virginia/Ohio. The \$10 Italian dinner was excellent, as was the door prize drawing since I won a box car which covered the cost of registration and dinner.

Of course there is always a down side, I missed seeing Mike Bradley's layout Sunday the 18<sup>th</sup> and I bought more than planned, including another type of track cleaning car.

Operation of my DD40AX DCC sound diesel was flawless with both DC and DCC on the Cantington layout. It could handle 50 hoppers, but was not able to replace the 3 GP-9s hauling 70-100 ton hoppers. Division One member, Bob Vensel is one of the founders of the Cantington layout, which is the combination of the city names Canton and Huntington.

Planning has begun for the  $7^{th}$  Ohio N-Scale Weekend (15 – 17, 2015) at the Franklin County Fairgrounds in Hilliard, Ohio. Details can be found shortly at www.centralohiontrak.org.

Currently, Division One will have 5 modules incorporated into the N-Scale layout at the NMRA National Train Show in Cleveland.

## **MODULE GROUP**

Our next showing will be at the National Train Show in Cleveland, from July 16 through July 20, 2014. We will setup on Wednesday, July 16 and Thursday, July 17. The times will be announced, later, by E-mail. We will have approximately 92 straight modules plus the loop ends and corners. We are committing 8 straight modules and the industrial end modules. We will operate Friday, July 18, Saturday, July 19 and Sunday, July 20 in shifts and will be expected to commit to a firm time schedule. There will be more about this and the times in the E-mail.

Be sure to read the last page of the "2014 National Train Show Layout Information" package which was sent to everyone last month. It details the procedure to get your parking pass and "remote opener" to open the gate to the parking lot. It costs \$25.00 plus a \$50.00 deposit for the remote. The deposit is returned to you after the remote is returned to them.

Thanks go to David Hazlett, Lloyd Horst and Larry Brown for offering their NCE throttles for use at the NTS. We will need to operate tethered due to the radio interference from others in the area. Smart Phones with the proper DCC App installed will be usable if Larry Madson has the computer set up. I'm told the batteries do not last very long and having spare batteries is a must.

Anyone who works the 2014 NTS must have shirts and hats with the "Division" and "Module Group" logo. They are available through Jim Williams or Nils Sunberg. Please have this done immediately. We want to look good. Thanks to all who have already done this.

Bob Ashley, Jr. is adding Tortoise turnout machines to the industrial end modules. Anyone with experience in installing these machines, and can help him, please call him at 330-645-6175 or 216-905-8860. He is making a control panel and hopes to have diode routing, eventually. We need to complete this before the 2014 NTS.

We are planning to make a "staging fiddle yard" which will mount on the back side of the back drop on the right end. There will be (4) 10' spurs, including a program track. A switch ladder will lead to the outside #1 Main, near the curved crossover, on the right end modules. This project will start this summer and be ready for the Dalton show. I will notify everyone when we start to build the yard. A PDF of the design will be sent to everyone, later, by E-mail.

The Division portion of the 50-50 raffle is placed in the module fund. Let's try to be generous and spend \$5.00 for six tickets instead of \$1.00 for one ticket. Your help in funding the Module Group is appreciated.
