#### SUPERINTENDENT'S MESSAGE

The Achievement Program – Association Volunteer, did you volunteer or help at the National Convention? Did you realize that you have collected time towards the Association Volunteer? Although you need 60 certified time units to receive your certificate, your participation at the convention will help you get a lot closer. Here are some items that will give you time units towards your achievement award.



Individuals (and their crews) who open their home or club layout for tours in conjunction with NMRA conventions or other NMRA sponsored events earn credit of 3 TU/day that the layout is open for viewing to a maximum of 12 TU for a National event, 6 TU for a Regional event or 3 TU for a Divisional event. So in this case, if you had your layout open for a tour, or helped someone out during a tour, you would accumulate 3 TU/day up to a maximum of 12 TUs.

Individuals who participate in modular layouts in conjunction with NMRA Divisions or at NMRA sponsored events earn credit of 3 TU/day for each day that the layout is open for viewing at the event to a maximum of 12 TU for a National event, 6 TU for a Regional event or 3 TU for a Divisional event. So in this case, if you helped with the modules during the National Train Show, you can accumulate 3 TU/day up to a maximum of 12 TUs for the National Train Show.

A live clinic that is presented more than once earns Association Volunteer credits for each additional (the first presentation is credited toward Author) presentation at the following schedule: National Clinic -3 TU; Region Clinic -2 TU; Division Clinic -1 TU. So in this case, if you had presented a clinic before and presented it at the National Convention, you would receive 3 TUs.

I hope this gives you some guidance towards your own Achievement Program. If you need help, let us know.






#### **N-SCALE NEWS**

At the April meeting a discussion of obtaining a set of special run Division 1 Cars as a funding source was held. The author followed up in Cleveland with Micro-Trains on a re-release of its Akron Canton Youngtown box car with the addition of a Division 1 Logo and "Division 1 N-Trak". The cost for a 100 car order to the division would be approximately \$25.00/car. Based upon current collector and special run car sale pricing, cars would be sold at \$31 to \$35 per car. Return on investment would be between 24 to 41%. Problems are the up front investment, cars would not be available until April, and it would take at least a year to sell all the cars.

This should make for an interesting fund raising discussion at the October Meeting.

- 2. Tax Exempt Status. Still in limbo. The IRS has not responded.


#### H. New Business
